1. Check-in & check-out

Check-in: from 3pm to 8pm.

Check-out: by 11am (*late check-out only upon request and subject to availability*).

2. Identification & Access Codes

Access codes will be provided once we have received ID documents for all guests staying with us.

3. Respect & Quiet Hours

Quiet hours: 10pm to 8am.

Please respect your fellow guests and our neighbors by keeping noise to a minimum.

4. Smoking Policy

Smoking, including electronic cigarettes, is not permitted.

5. Cleanliness & Care

Daily cleaning is carried out between 11am and 1pm.

How to get here?

From FCO to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262

Option 1

Leonardo Express + Metro

Route:

- Take the Leonardo Express train from FCO to Termini Station..
- From Termini, board the Metro A line toward Battistini and get off at Manzoni.

Cost: **€ 15,50 per person**
Around € 14,00 (train)
+ € 1,50 (metro ticket).

Time:

- About 30 minutes on the train.
- Plus 3 minutes on the metro.
- Plus a 10-minute walk to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262.

Option 2

Leonardo Express + Bus (714)

Route:

- Take the Leonardo Express train from FCO to Termini Station.
- Walk about 3 minutes to Piazza Cinquecento (main bus stop).
- Take the 714 bus from Piazza Cinquecento to Piazza San Giovanni.

Cost: **€ 15,50 per person**
Around € 14,00 (train)
+ € 1,50 (metro ticket).

Time:

- About 30 minutes on the train.
- Plus 15-20 minutes on the bus, depending on traffic and time of day.
- Short walk from bus stop to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262.

Option 3

Taxi o Uber

- Municipal Taxi Fixed Fare: € 55,00.
- Uber Estimate: Around € 60,00, depending on traffic and circumstances .

Time:

- About 30-40 minutes, depending on traffic.

From CIA to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262

Option 1

Bus (Terravision) + Metro

Route:

- Take the Terravision bus from Ciampino to Termini Station.
- From Termini, board the Metro A line toward Battistini and get off at Manzoni.
- Walk about 10 minutes to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262.

Cost: **€ 7,50-€ 8,50 per person**
Around € 6,00 (bus)
+ € 1,50 (metro).

Time:

- About 40 minutes on the Terravison bus, depending on traffic.
- Plus 3 minutes on the metro.
- Plus 10 min walk to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano 262.

Option 3

Taxi o Uber

- Municipal Taxi Fixed Fare: €40,00.
- Uber Estimate: Around € 60,00, depending on traffic and circumstances.

Time:

- About 30-40 minutes, depending on traffic.

Option 2

Bus (Terravision) + 714 bus

Route:

- Take the bus from Ciampino to Termini Station.
- Walk about 3 minutes to Piazza Cinquecento (main bus stop).
- Take the 714 bus from Piazza Cinquecento to Piazza San Giovanni.

Cost: **€ 7,50 per person**
Around € 6,00 (bus)
+ €1,50 (bus ticket).

Time:

- About 40 minutes on the Terravison bus, depending on traffic.
- Plus 15-20 minutes on the bus, depending on traffic and time of day.
- Short walk from bus stop to Via di San Giovanni in Laterano.

The “Nasoni” of Rome

The water flowing from the famous Nasoni fountains in Rome largely comes from the Roman aqueducts, extraordinary feats of engineering that have withstood over two thousand years.

These aqueducts, built in ancient Rome, are masterpieces of precision and innovation: they channeled water from distant sources through majestic arches and tunnels, bringing life and comfort to the eternal city.

Today, thanks to a modern distribution system, part of this historic water continues to flow through public pipelines, testifying to the ingenuity of ancient Roman engineers and underscoring the importance of preserving this millennial heritage.

These ancient aqueducts are not just spectacular architectural achievements—they are a living legacy, demonstrating how Rome harnessed a combination of technology and culture that has lasted for centuries, making water accessible and vital for all.

The Secret Parks of Rome

Green spaces waiting to be discovered.

Everyone knows Villa Borghese and Villa Pamphili, but the Eternal City also hides smaller green treasures that truly deserve to be discovered.

Around Rome for Two, you'll find several very special ones. Just a short walk from the Colosseum lies **Colle Oppio** (about a 10-minute walk) – a peaceful oasis offering a wonderful view of the monument.

Not far from there is the enchanting **Parco Celimontana** (about 15 minutes on foot), perfect for a stroll among centuries-old trees and a relaxed atmosphere.

For those who love walking a bit more, a romantic route will lead you toward Aventine Hill and San Saba, passing by the **Circus Maximus** (about 20 minutes on foot). Once you reach the **Giardino degli Aranci** (about 30–35 minutes on foot), you can enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the Tiber and the Eternal City.

Just a few steps away (about 3 minutes on foot) hides a truly unique spot: a door with a keyhole that, if you peek through, perfectly frames one of Rome's most iconic monuments – we'll leave you the pleasure of discovering which one! **Remember, in Rome, every corner hides a secret and a piece of history waiting to be found.**
